GMSC PROCESS

The GMSC team builds and curates a centralized two-page resume bank of qualified, incoming DAF military spouses through partnerships with Military & Family Readiness Centers. These two-page resumes are then shared with the gaining Civilian Personnel Office to help connect transitioning talent directly with local hiring managers and available opportunities.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

U.S Citizenship

Must be DAF-Active Duty Spouse

Ability to Pass a Background Check

Have PCS Orders

Must Qualify and Meet Conditions of Employment

Moving is stressful enough; finding the right professional network in a new location shouldn't be a barrier. The Global Military Spouse Connection (GMSC) program is a new Department of the Air Force (DAF) initiative focused on connecting transitioning military spouses with federal employment networks and hiring managers prior to their Permanent Change of Station (PCS) move.

HOW IT WORKS

Eligibility for the initial phase is limited to DAF spouses married to active-duty members with PCS orders to Travis AFB, Patrick SFB, or Ramstein AB.

- 1 GET CONNECTED**
When you receive your PCS orders, connect with the GMSC team or local Military & Family Readiness Center (M&FRC).
- 2 SHARE YOUR TALENT**
Submit your two-page resume to the GMSC talent pool, highlighting your skills, education, and experience.
- 3 WE HELP COORDINATE**
We take your two-page resume and deliver it directly to the Human Resources team at your new installation.
- 4 DIRECT MATCHING**
Your new base matches your two-page resume with managers looking to hire.
